Research: Identify roles that match your unique blend of strengths, interests, and values.

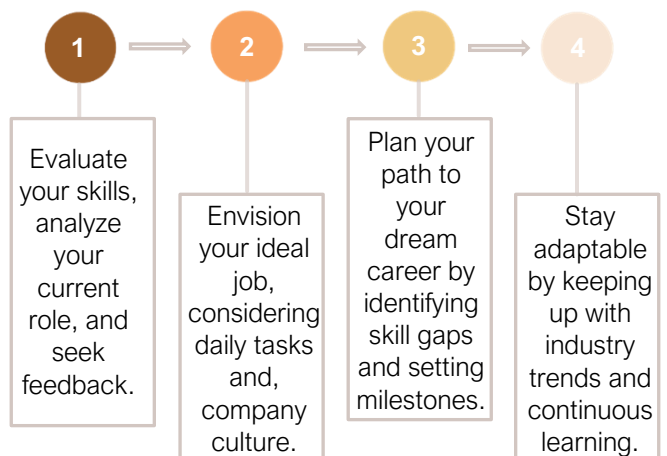
